He always carries a trumpet, which he blows to get everyone's attention before he makes his proclamations. Dina is the angel of learning, - she loves to help others learn how to think and do things. Roma Downey is an actress, author, and producer. Born and raised in Ireland, Roma is best known for her Emmy and Golden Globe nominated role as Monica, the gentle hearted angel and star of the hit television series "Touched by An Angel" which aired on CBS for 9 seasons. This summer, she was on the Hallmark Channel starring in the TV movie "Keeping up with the Randalls." Last year she was also on Hallmark in their summer hit "Come Dance At My Wedding."

Her career began as a celebrated stage actress, having starred in multiple Broadway, Off Broadway, and with the famed Abbey Players of Ireland. She has also appeared on stage at the Los Angeles Geffen Theatre, Boston's Colonial theatre and the Kennedy Center in Washington DC.

Her growing popularity led to her notable role as American icon Jackie Kennedy Onassis ("Jackie O") in the Emmy Award Winning miniseries, "A Woman Named Jackie."

Additionally, Downey has both executive produced and starred in multiple hit movies for CBS television, most notably "Borrowed Hearts," "Monday After The Miracle," "A Secret Life," "The Sons of Mistletoe" and "The Survivors Club."

Downey hosted "It's a Miracle" for the PAX Network, an uplifting and inspiring talk show devoted to the exploration of real life miracles.

She has guested on Oprah, Leno, Letterman, Conan, Regis and The View and she has graced the cover of countless publications, and was honored with being named one of People Magazines "100 Most Beautiful People."

She is a national spokesperson for Operation Smile, a charitable organization which provides help and corrective surgeries to the over 200,000 children born with severe cleft lip conditions throughout the world. Through Operation Smile, she has travelled to Central America, to Asia and to the Middle East on international medical missions and was accompanied by her husband Mark and their three children, Reilly, James and Cameron to Jordan where they donated the equipment, supplies and training funds necessary to construct and operate the Roma Downey Life Support Training Center in Amman.

Downey is also an accomplished author, having written two children's books, "Love is a Family" and "Leave a Message with the Moon" She has recorded an inspirational album of spoken word and poetry called "Healing Angel."

Roma lives in Malibu, CA with her husband, producer Mark Burnett, their three teenage children and their two very large Irish wolfhounds, Finn McCool and Maximus!
